Subject: Lake Committee Meeting

The Lake Committee met on Thursday, August 8th. Those in attendance were Marilyn Waldorf, Dan Papich, Janet Ripberger, Margaret Walter, Dorothy [redacted], and Tom Donaldson. Stan Gilson, Anne Seigel, and Joan Galtz did not attend.

Lake History and Usage

[redacted] gave an overview stating all lakes are tied together and should be treated as one. It was suggested we hire one company to treat all the lakes. The majority (including a telephone message from [redacted]) agreed.

Discussion/ Suggestions

Payment for services is a mixed bag, some owners wanting to continue paying as a small group, others feel the entire neighborhood should pay.

It was suggested the issue of payment be put on the next annual meeting ballot (some thought the board would "shove it down throats anyway")

Some expressed fear that if the neighborhood pays, their privacy would be at risk, i.e. people would enter their property to access lake--- stating they have "paid for the right"

A letter should be put in the Newsletter stating the ownership rights of the lake owners -- Private -- stay off.

Recommendation to the Board

Each person was asked to state their positions on the issue, they are as follows:

- [redacted] -- Does not want board involvement, leave us alone, leave as is.
- [redacted] -- Let AWHOA take over, hire one contractor and bill entire neighborhood
